## THE LAUNCH OF OUR TY MICRO-MODULE

This year, we launched our **TY Micro-Module**, developed in line with the guidelines of the National Council for Curriculum and Assessment (NCCA). As one of only a small number of providers delivering a programme to this standard, we are delighted to support schools nationwide with practical legal literacy education.

### MICRO-MODULE OUTLINE:



#### DURATION:

20-Hours (3-Hour onsite workshop and 17-hour eLearning course.)



#### STRUCTURE:

A blended model, combining expert-led workshops with independent eLearning.



#### ASSESSMENT:

Integrated quizzes, progress reports and reflective tasks to support learning.

Alongside our continued work with students nationwide, we also continued supporting graduates through CareerEd by LawEd, our career preparation and mentoring service for those pursuing legal and related careers.
